(B) ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(A). GENERAL

1. ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur has been established and incorporated under the Act 17 of 2008 passed by Rajasthan State Legislature and notified by the Government of Rajasthan through its official Gazette Notification No. F.2 (23) Vidhi /2/2008 dated April 21, 2008.

The Jyoti Vidyapeeth Trust, a Public Trust, is the Sponsoring Body of the University. The Trust was created by execution of a Trust Deed on 14th November, 2003 under provision of the Registration Act 1908 (Central Act No 16 of 1908) noted at serial number 1417 of the book no 4, in the office of Sub-Registrar, Jaipur II.

The University Presently offers more than 70 programs for the award of Certificates, Diplomas, First Degree, Master and Doctoral Degrees in General and Professional fields in Normal or Dual Mode. The Jayoti Vidyapeeth women's University strives to become a leader in disciplinary teaching and research keeping integration of classroom learning with the real world experiences. The University has been making significant contribution for the empowerment of women by exploiting its full efforts and resources in providing equal status, Opportunities and freedom to women for their development through education and motivation.

At present only 8 Women's Universities exist in India out of which 2 are Deemed Universities and 5 are funded and governed by different State Governments. Pedagogy

The University inculcates conceptual and technical skills in students through teaching methodology based on lectures, Case studies, Presentations, Mock Interviews, Seminars, Group Discussions, Projects, Assignments, Quizzes, etc., well supplemented by overhead projectors, Touch Panels, LCD projectors and audio visual display.

(i) Laboratories

In all branches of Faculties / Directorates / Departments, the University imparts effective technical training to the students in workshops and laboratories.

(ii) Lectures

Regular class lectures are arranged on each subject by well-qualified and experienced permanent /visiting faculty members.

(iii) Seminars

The exchange of ideas and sharing of knowledge helps to inculcate the awareness of the latest technology in students.

(iv) Group Discussions

The group discussions form a regular feature of the teaching methodology where students, in a group of six to eight, discuss various topics related to their field and also of current awareness.

(v) PDP Classes

Regular sessions for personality development are conducted. Their proficiency is reinforced through the sessions by emphasizing development of the interactive, creative and analytical skills.

(vi) Assignments

Students are given assignments for which they require to collect material and a write-up within the specified time-period for submitting it to the concerned faculty.

(vii) Quizzes

Quizzes are arranged weekly, consisting of questions from the subjects taught in a Trimester of General Awareness, Business Round-up, etc.

(viii) Project-generation

Students are motivated to undertake certain projects related to their branches. Brain- storming sessions are conducted by the senior faculty members to help them to generate, execute and implement such projects.

(ix) Continuous Assessment

Continuous Assessment is made through class room participations, class assignments, seminar presentation, quizzes, class tests, Mid-Term and End-Term Examinations.

(x) Case Studies

Case studies are done by the students under the guidance of respective faculty members.

(xi) **Mock Interviews**

To make familiar with the placement interviews, students have been gone through the mock interviews to present themselves in a professional way.

The Objective

To train and develop highly skilled and efficient manpower to make ready for employment in industry and research organizations. As a result of the sound research base and extensive infrastructural facilities available, the University offers M. Phil. / Ph.D. program in a wide range of areas in **Pharmacy, Physics, Chemistry, Life Sciences & Biotechnology, Mathematical Sciences, Computer Science & Information Technology, Electronics & Telecommunication, Management & Commerce, Hindi, English, Public Administration, Home Science, Political Science, Geography, History and Social Sciences** etc.

Research Facilities:

All the departments of the University have well equipped research laboratories and workshop facilities. In addition, there are a number of central facilities, which include Computer Centre, Central Library, Workshop, Xerox and Photography Sections. The Master Vinit Central Library is a multistoried air-conditioned building with a capacity of 300 students has been provided in the campus. It offers large & spacious reading rooms, research facilities & provides the academic environment for studies and research. The students as well as staff members may read the books round the clock. The fully automated library system is based on Libsys Software with the unique feature of Web-OPAC Technology. The Digital library provides On-Line Access of Database and Full Text abstracts with Internet facility with a capacity of 40 IBM computers fully upgraded with latest technology. The library resources can be accessed online.

It has a collection of 21,022 **books** in the discipline of :- Management, Engineering- Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, Electronics, Pharmacy, Environmental Science, Medical Science, Political Science, History ,Literature : English & Hindi etc and reference sources and subscribes to **102** Periodicals besides print materials. It has 600 multimedia resources. It is opened on all seven days. It remains open beyond teaching hours. It has 110 Journals (40- Online & International-8), 600 DVDs & CDs, 30 Informatory Magazines & more than 17 News papers with multi copies.

The Institute has many research collaborations with leading Research Institutes / Organizations. As part of these collaborations, the post graduate students get opportunities to carry out joint research projects with professionals and experts from these organizations.

3. Students Amenities

University is fully residential and is facilitated with Four well furnished separate multi storied hostels with the capacity of total 1400 students. Each hostel is an independent entity with its own recreation areas, etc. All the students can stay in the campus throughout their tenure of study. This hostel accomadation includes several types of rooms having air cooled and air conditioned facilities with all the basic and modern amenities like mess, reading

room, games, medical facility, incoming ccall facility and wi-fi internet facility. However students may be permitted to have their own arrangements for accommodation outside campus.

Extracurricular activities are provided by the Various Clubs and Jayoti Sangh. These activities include sports, cultural programmes, social service and the NCC. Various clubs activities encourage individual talents of students in areas such as Entrepreneurship, research related activities, creative writing, painting, music, fabrication of electronic devices etc.

Social Responsibility:

The University is situated in rural area and this area is not only suffering from illiteracy, ignorance, superstitions but also from lack of medicinal facilities. For the benefit of such rural population the University started rural medical services in the nearest villages with the help of Village Panchayat Jharna from 13th July 2009. University runs three peripheral clinics with the Homoeopathic Physicians in nearby rural areas. The medical team treats the patients of villages free of cost. The University has also been running the free check up camps in schools and colleges for their students. Students of NSS & Jayoti Sangh survey in nearby villages and also provide services s per the villagers' need. University organizes health camps, blood donation camps, plantation camps etc. University conducts Awareness Programs, Mahila Sashaktikaran Abhiyan & other activities. The students are also involved in **Community Development Activities**, through which they design, fabricate and implement various indigenous projects, helping the rural community to become self sustaining and developing in the areas related to Health, Education and Employment.

4. Ph.D. Programme

As a result of the sound research base and extensive infrastructural facilities available, the University offers Ph.D. programme in a wide range of areas in Engineering, Science & Humanities and Social Sciences. The broad objectives of the Ph.D. programme is not only to keep pace with the expanding frontiers of knowledge but also to provide research training relevant to the present social and economic objectives of the country.

The academic programme leading to the Ph.D. degree is broad based and involves a minimum course credit requirement and research thesis. The University also encourages research in interdisciplinary areas through a system of joint supervision and interdepartmental group activities. The presence of a strong research oriented faculty provides excellent opportunities for such programme. The University undertakes sponsored research and development projects from industrial and other organizations in public as well as private sector.

Facilities for research work leading to the Ph.D. degree are available in the departments of Computer Science and Engineering, Biotechnology and Allied Sciences, Electronics and Communications, Management and Commerce, Humanities and Social Sciences, and Pharmaceutical Science.

5. General Eligibility Criterion For Admission

One of the following in appropriate areas:

- 55 % marks in Master's Degree or its equivalent in related area (50 % for SC/ST/OBC).
- First Class Bachelor Degree in Engineering & Technology (50% for SC/ST/OBC), with one of the following additional requirement –
 - Valid GATE Score
 - Professional work experience of minimum 2 years
- M. Phil with 55 % marks in Master's Degree or its equivalent in related area (50 % for SC/ST/OBC) for Ph. D. only.

Note:-

- In-Campus programme of Ph.D. degree shall be available for women Research Scholars only.
- Ph.D. Programme shall be available for both men (external) & women Research Scholars.
- Hostel accommodation shall be available for Women Research Scholars only.

6. Categories of Ph.D. candidates

Duration of the programme:

Minimum 2 yrs from the date of registration (3 yrs for External candidates).

The University admits Ph.D. candidates under the following categories:

- **Regular Research Scholar**

Regular Research Scholar shall mean a student selected for Ph.D. program without any financial assistance and remains self financed throughout the program. The minimum duration of program will be 2 years from the date of registration.

- **External Research Scholar**
External Research Scholar shall mean a student selected for Ph.D. program without any financial assistance and remains self financed on part time basis. The minimum duration of program will be 3 years from the date of registration.
- **Regular Research Associate**
Regular Research Associate shall mean a student selected for Ph.D. program with financial assistance either fellowship from our University or from other bodies like UGC/CSIR-JRF/QIP/DAE/DST/DBT etc. The minimum duration of program will be 2 years from the date of registration.
- **External Research Associate**
External Research Associate shall mean a student selected for Ph.D. program with financial assistance from other bodies like UGC/CSIR-JRF/QIP/DAE/DST/DBT etc. The minimum duration of program will be 3 years from the date of registration.

7. Admission Procedure

- A candidate desirous of taking admission in the Ph.D. has to appear for an Entrance Examination, conducted by the University at specified centers.
- NET qualified and M. Phil candidates are NOT exempted from the entrance examination.
- Research Scholars whose selection is approved by the Chairman, JRA (on the basis of written examination & interview) will be given provisional admission (enrolled) to the Ph.D. programme after payment of prescribed Pre Registration fee (Non refundable).

1. Application for Admission

- The prescribed Application Form may be obtained from the University website www.jvwomensuniv.com.
- Any applicant satisfying the criteria and seeking admission to the Ph.D. programme shall in the first instance submit an application in the prescribed Application Form
- The Ph.D. programme shall be open to Research Scholars (Male / Female) of any Nationality provided that the Research Scholars satisfies the criteria for admission
- The research areas of each of the department offering Ph. D. programme shall be displayed on the University website.

2. Entrance Examination

- After the scrutiny of the application, only those Research Scholars who fulfill the requirement of the University admission criteria will be allowed to sit for the entrance examination.
- The University shall conduct Entrance Examination at specified centers.
- The syllabi of written Exam for admission in Research Programmes will be as decided by JRA.
- The Ph.D. Entrance Test would consist of 2 parts:

Part I will be General Aptitude Test which shall be common to all applicants and Part II will be Subject Specific Test which shall examine basic fundamental knowledge of the subject reflecting the ability of the Research Scholars to address subject related problems.

- The question paper shall contain 100 questions of objective type. 30 % questions will be based on General Aptitude. The remaining 70 % questions will be set on the subject concerned.
- The syllabi of the General Aptitude Test and the Subject Specific Test will be displayed on the University website.

3. Interview

- Only those Research Scholars who have successfully cleared the written examination will be called for the interview

- At the time of interview, the Research Scholars are expected to indicate their field of Interest.

4. Selection

- Selection to the Ph.D. programmes would be based on previous Academic record, Performance in an entrance test followed by an Interview at the University Campus

8. Provisional Admission

- Research Scholars whose selection is approved by the Chairperson, JRA (on the basis of written examination & interview) will be given provisional admission to the Ph.D. programme after payment of prescribed Pre Registration fee (Non refundable).
- Provisionally selected Research Scholars will be notified about the further procedure for admission after the interview, on the University website /by Post.
- Provisionally selected Research Scholars will be required to take admission by the specified date; failing which the allotted seats shall be given to another Research Scholars in the waiting list.
- The waiting list of Research Scholars shall be posted on the website.

Note: - If the synopsis of the selected Research Scholars is not approved by the JRA, the University shall give chance to the other Research Scholars as per waiting list.

9. Allotment of Supervisor

Allotment of Research scholar to supervisors will be made by the Chairman of the Board of Research Studies on recommendation made by the Head of the Department taking in to consideration the areas of research of the department.

11. Financial Support

Students joining Ph.D. programme may be considered for Teaching / Research / Technical Assistantship based on the University norms and will be provided with monthly stipend on the basis of their satisfactory performance of the same.

12. Registration for the Ph.D. Degree

After a candidate has been provisionally admitted to the University, he/she has to undertake the Ph.D. Course work and Synopsis presentation, the guidelines of which are as follows:

i. Ph. D. Coursework Plan (Regular/External)

The Ph.D. Research Scholars are required to undertake Ph.D. coursework of one semester duration within one year (two years in case of external Research Scholars) from the date of registration in to the programme in accordance with the University Academic Schedule.

A. The Research Scholar shall be allowed to undertake the Research work after successful completion of the following **Core coursework**, which shall comprise of 4 papers:

- Research Methodology
- Computer Applications
- Quantitative & Statistical Techniques
- Dissertation on Review of Literature

- The Coursework shall comprise of 40 credits (each credit is equivalent to 15 hrs of studies) including eight credits for Certificate of Community Awareness Education, which has to be undertaken at the University Campus both by the Regular & External Research Scholars.
- For Regular Research Scholars: Coursework of 600hrs is to be undertaken in First Two semesters and Minimum contact hours for research work required shall be 360 hrs in 2 yrs. For External Research Scholars: Coursework

of 600hrs is to be undertaken in First Four Semesters and Minimum contact hours for research work required shall be 360 hrs in 3 yrs.

- The Syllabus & Schedule of the coursework shall be posted on the University Website.
- The research scholar is required to submit a dissertation on the Review of research work published / carried out so far in its chosen field.
- There shall be no Community Development Activity, Extra-curricular Activity & Co-curricular Activity in the programme.
- All the Examination Rules of the Department of Examination shall be applicable on evaluation of Ph.D. Coursework.
- The minimum period required for completion of a Ph.D. programme shall be two years (Three years in case of External Research Scholars) after the date of registration.
- Examinations of the University shall be open to all the Research Scholars who have undergone a course of study in the University for a period specified for that programme of study in the Teaching & Evaluation scheme for Ph.D. courses.

Synopsis & its Presentation

- The research scholar is required to prepare a synopsis of the proposed Ph.D. research programme in consultation with his/her supervisor(s) and submit the synopsis to the JRA within the 90 days of the enrollment.
- The scholar shall give a presentation on his/her proposed research work before the JRA members on a date and time notified by the Chairman, JRA.
- The Research Scholar shall submit 5 copies of the synopsis at the time of presentation.
- The Subject Research Committee (SRC) shall submit its recommendations on the presentation to the JRA with reference to the suitability of the research proposal.
- The JRA will inform the registrar about the recommended list of scholars found suitable for registration. It shall also submit the list to the Board of Research Studies for favor of information.
- The Registrar will notify the registration of the research scholars.
- The date of approval of the synopsis and its presentation shall be the date of registration in the Ph.D. Programme.

(Registration is confirmed as per rules, after successfully completion of course credit requirements).

13. Progress Report

1. Research scholar of Ph. D. programme shall sign the attendance register on all working days. They shall be eligible for a total of 15 days leave every semester and subject to a total maximum of 30 days in a year, which they can avail only after obtaining HOD / Research Monitor permission.
2. A Research scholar of Ph. D. programme shall submit a written report of the work done by him / her to the Research Monitor through supervisor within two weeks before the end of 12 months from the date of registration and before the end of each 6 months period beyond one year.
3. A Research scholar of Ph. D. programme shall appear before the Research Monitor at least once in every semester.

14. Submission of thesis and award of degree

- Subject to fulfilling the course credit requirements and other conditions as may be laid down from time to time, the candidate may submit the Ph.D. thesis after two years from the date of registration (3 years for external candidates).

- The Research scholar shall, within three months of submission of the summary, submit seven copies of thesis embodying the results of investigation, along with CD's of its soft copies in PDF format. However, on the recommendation of the Research Referee, the JRA may extend the time of submission by another three months.
- The thesis submitted for the Ph. D. degree shall contain an account of the research work carried out by the scholar leading to the discovery of new facts or techniques or new correlation of facts already known (analytical and / or experimental and / or hardware oriented in nature), the work should be of such quality that it makes a definite contribution to the advancement of knowledge.
- The cover of the Ph.D. thesis shall be of colour as given below:

○ Faculty of Engineering & Technology	Green
○ Faculty of Medical Science	Yellow
○ Faculty of Management & Humanities	Blue
○ Faculty of Law & Governance	White
- The Thesis should contain a certificate obtained from the supervisor stating the period of mandatory contact hours spend in research with the supervisor. The minimum contact hours for Regular Research Scholars are 360 in two years and three years in the case of External Research Scholars.
